

IMPORTER OF RECORD

IOR Requirements:

- MX Entity or resident (Individual or Corporation).
- RFC TAX ID.
- Imports License.
- Responsible for duties, taxes and other customs fees payment.
- Customs Broker set up
- Recordkeeping 5 years

- o NOMs



DOCUMENTS

COMMERCIAL INVOICE
BILL OF LADING /AWB



CERTIFICATE OF ORIGIN

- Serial number
- Model number

Note: Spanish, English or French



MEXICAN CUSTOMS BROKER

LIABLE FOR THE DECLARATION INFORMATION

- HTS
- Quantity
- Country of Origin
- Compliance with nontariff barriers and labeling & quality requirements (NOMs)

COMPLIANCE INSPECTION 'PREVIO"

- "Previo" takes place in the US Forwarder or Fiscal Warehouse.
- Labeling, US Export Certificates.

Recordkeeping 5 Years

MEXICAN HTS

DETERMINES

- Admissibility (Nontariff barrier, NOMs)
 Duty rate, FTA's, anti-dumping (0% to 35%)
 - 8 digits code + 2MX Rulings
 - Classification discrepanciesUSMCA



CUSTOMS DECLARATION

• Formal Entry:

Pedimento / Remesa

- MX Customs Broker or "Legal Representative" (Self Filer)
- o Imports License
- Fiscal Form: Duties, Taxes and other customs fees declaration
- All entries require a MX Importer/Exporter of Record or MX sponsor
- Informal Entries

DECREE 544 HTS CODES

April 22,2024

544 HTS codes


Import duties from 5 up to 50%

Steel, aluminum, textiles, apparel, footwear, wood, plastic and its manufactures, paper, cardboard, ceramic products, glass, electrical material, transportation material, furniture, etc.

ENFORCED ON APRIL 23, 2024; AND WILL BE VALID FOR 2 YEARS.




